Whole School Priority 1 – Improving Provision and Pupil Progress

Appropriate, adaptive and absorbing provision will result in improved engagement and pupil progress

Aim: to improve pupil progress resulting in improved opportunities. In particular to focus on achievements of groups of pupils. Improving pupil progression across the year and reducing the impact of poverty on learners' progression and attainment. Subject specific improvements are needed in different areas.

Whole School Priority 2 – Attitudes to School and Learning

High achievement always takes place in the framework of high expectations.

Aim: to improve attitudes to school and learning, increasing attendance and punctuality and driving high expectations in uniform, the quality of work and attitude to learning to increase success and pupil progress.

Whole School Priority 3 – Continually improving skills equals improved progress in all subjects

Aim: 3a. To improve provision for skill development through professional learning and the sharing of good practice, focussing on subject specific needs.
